



# KNIGHT'S CLUB BONUS POINT OPPORTUNITIES

God's Word, the Bible, encourages us to study, memorize and apply what it says. As we do that, we grow closer to God and understand more about how God wants us to live!

At KNIGHT'S CLUB each child will have the opportunity to choose an award for which they will work during the year by earning points above and beyond the weekly memory verse, bringing their Bible or inviting a friend. Each age division will have specifically assigned Bible passages, lists, or Bible facts from which to choose and have the full year of KNIGHT'S CLUB to learn them and accumulate points.

It is our belief that not only is it beneficial for Christians to learn what God's Word teaches but how we make that teaching be part of our everyday lives. That is the ultimate Goal of KNIGHT'S CLUB and we encourage children to not only memorize for the KNIGHT'S CLUB award, but through learning these things, grow closer to God!

## Here's What To Do...

- Choose where you want to begin
- Study and work until you are able to recite it word for word to one of the Verse Listeners
- You will be asked to recite it a 2nd time the next week after which the bonus points will be awarded
- Choose another and begin again!
- Awards will be presented at a special time of celebration at designated times throughout the school year

### Advanced Bible Memorization Challenges

Any child or preteen is welcome to try to meet this challenge! Many children work to learn verses out of God's Word, but there's something very special about learning important chapters or sections of God's Word. These are known as "special swords", because so many Christians have used them to help them get through the challenging parts of life.

#### Here's what you do:

1. Pick one chapter or section of verses from the list provided in this brochure.
2. You can learn it in any version you want: KJV, NIV, CEV, or any other version.
3. The 4's, 5's and Kindergarten learn 1/2 of a passage or section; Grades 1 & 2 learn just 3/4 of a section; Grades 3-6 must learn the entire passage.

#### YOUR SPECIAL AWARD

Every child who succeeds will earn their own special knight. The knight will be awarded in a special ceremony.

#### WHEN YOU FINISH ONE...

....you are welcome to try and learn another, or stop there. You can earn as many Knights as there are passages or sections. If you work hard, you could have a whole collection!

#### PARENTS PLEASE NOTE

This challenge is in addition to the verses the children will be learning each week. It is not required, but is something extra a child can choose to do.

#### HOW GOOD DOES IT NEED TO BE?

You know you are ready to say it when you can say it and make less than three mistakes. Even better, try to say it with no mistakes!

#### WHEN YOU ARE READY TO SAY IT...

- Let your teacher and the Verse Ladies know that you will be ready to say your chapter soon. **Try to let them know at least one week in advance.**
- Bring the Bible that you used to memorize it, so the listeners will know the exact words.
- In Verse Time, after all the children in your group are finished saying that week's verse, you will have a chance to say your verses.
- Do your best as you say it.
- If you are not able to say it without making more than three mistakes, you can try again later on another night, whenever you feel that you are ready.
