What is unique about Knight's Club?

What the Children are Learning

This year, all children will focus on building within them Christian Character from being truthful to forgiving and so much more!

Learning Bible Verses

Children are taught a Bible verse each week during Knight's Club, using exciting learning games and activities. The purpose of this is to allow the child to spend the rest of the week reviewing the verse, instead of trying to learn it in one night. Most of the children in the Club are learning the same Bible verse together each week, and the verse always relates to their teaching for that night. Each week, children will bring home a flyer with the verse for the week, club announcements and updates.

Children are encouraged to do their very best in learning the verses. The goal is for them to remember the verses for a life-time, not just to learn them long enough to say them. Children can be given up to 3 prompts to say their verse. Specially trained verse listeners listen to the children's verses each week, so the same standard is applied to every child.

Offering

Each week, children are invited to bring an offering. At the end of the year, our offering will be sent to help missionaries overseas. Our offering totals will be celebrated from time to time. Families dealing with financial difficulty do not need to contribute. No dues are required.

Reward Program

Children choose a reward when they first begin to attend, then work on earning points toward that specific reward in the weeks that follow. On the night they get the final points, they get to take their award home! This is designed to encourage the value of saving.

Point System

Not every child is good at memorizing, so other point opportunities are available:

Being Present	25 Points
Being on Time	50 Points
Bringing Your Bible	200 Points
Reciting Bible Verse	300 Points
Bringing a Friend	200 Points

Extra Point Opportunity

Children can choose to memorize selected Bible passages for extra credit. These will be learned on their own, but can be recited any-time the child is ready. A child may be asked to recite the Bible chapter or passage a 2nd time, to assure they know and understand the passage. For each Bible passage, they earn extra points, as well as their own small knight figurine. If a child succeeds in memorizing all of them in the course of this year's Club, they will be awarded a life-size knight!

Another option, designed more for the younger children, is memorizing important Bible lists. Children who recite lists can earn extra points, but do not earn knights.

We Are Praying For Your Child

Every Wednesday night before Club starts, all staff serving that night meet together to pray for your children and help us focus on God's plan for that night. Because of this, classrooms will not open until after 6:05 each Wednesday evening.

Your Child's Safety

The safety of your child is important to us. Because of that, our church uses a security system that includes the following:

- A permission form, signed by the parent or legal guardian.
- Signing children in and out
- A parent security tag
- An On-Site Security Staff

Snack

Snacks are served each week to the children during the program. Each parent is asked to take a turn bringing a snack for their child's class.

Dress
